# Your Page...

Let's meet our new Grapevine Representative Dale M. from Monday Night Derry under the Bridge homegroup with some Q&A to provide information in support of our A.A. publication.

Q: Greetings Dale! What kind of service work have you been involved with previously?

A: If anything is needed to be done, I do it. At my homegroup, I have been the treasurer, secretary, and the Grapevine representative. When I first came into AA, I was the coffee maker and set up person.

Q: How has performing service work for the Grapevine actively been a part of your AA program?

A: Well, the Grapevine tells right there in its Statement of Purpose, from 1946, Bill W. expressed that "The Grapevine will be the voice of the Alcoholics Anonymous movement it is to mirror...there will be but one central purpose: The Grapevine will try to carry the A.A. message to alcoholics and to practice the A.A. principles in all its affairs." It carries the message of A.A. and I have the honor to be of service in District 23 as the Grapevine Representative and serve my homegroup in the same way. It's great because I am a big believer in the power of the Grapevine, that's why I stood for the district position.

Q: Since the emergence of the COVID-19 pandemic, how do you implement Grapevine materials into your recovery?

A: I hold an electronic subscription to the grapevine. By being a subscription holder, I get daily inspirations and stories sent to me. Every day I'm reminded on my phone when it sends me alerts about reflections and inspirations from the Grapevine. Having that tool when meetings were few and far between really helped.

Q: Where can we find Grapevine books or subscribe to the Grapevine?

A: www.aagrapevine.org or call 1-800-631-6025. That's the hotline number, the people on the other end are very helpful. They'll help you find any books or literature. You can even get wall hangings for the rooms of A.A. acronyms, 12 steps, traditions, it is a good source for anything A.A. They send everything in a black plastic wrapper, so we stay anonymous.

Q: Do you have a favorite publication and if so, why?

A: It's the Grapevine magazine, for alcoholics, by alcoholics, it's like a meeting in your pocket. My favorite issue would be December 2020 because it explains how we overcame covid-19 and continued to help the alcoholic who still is suffering.
